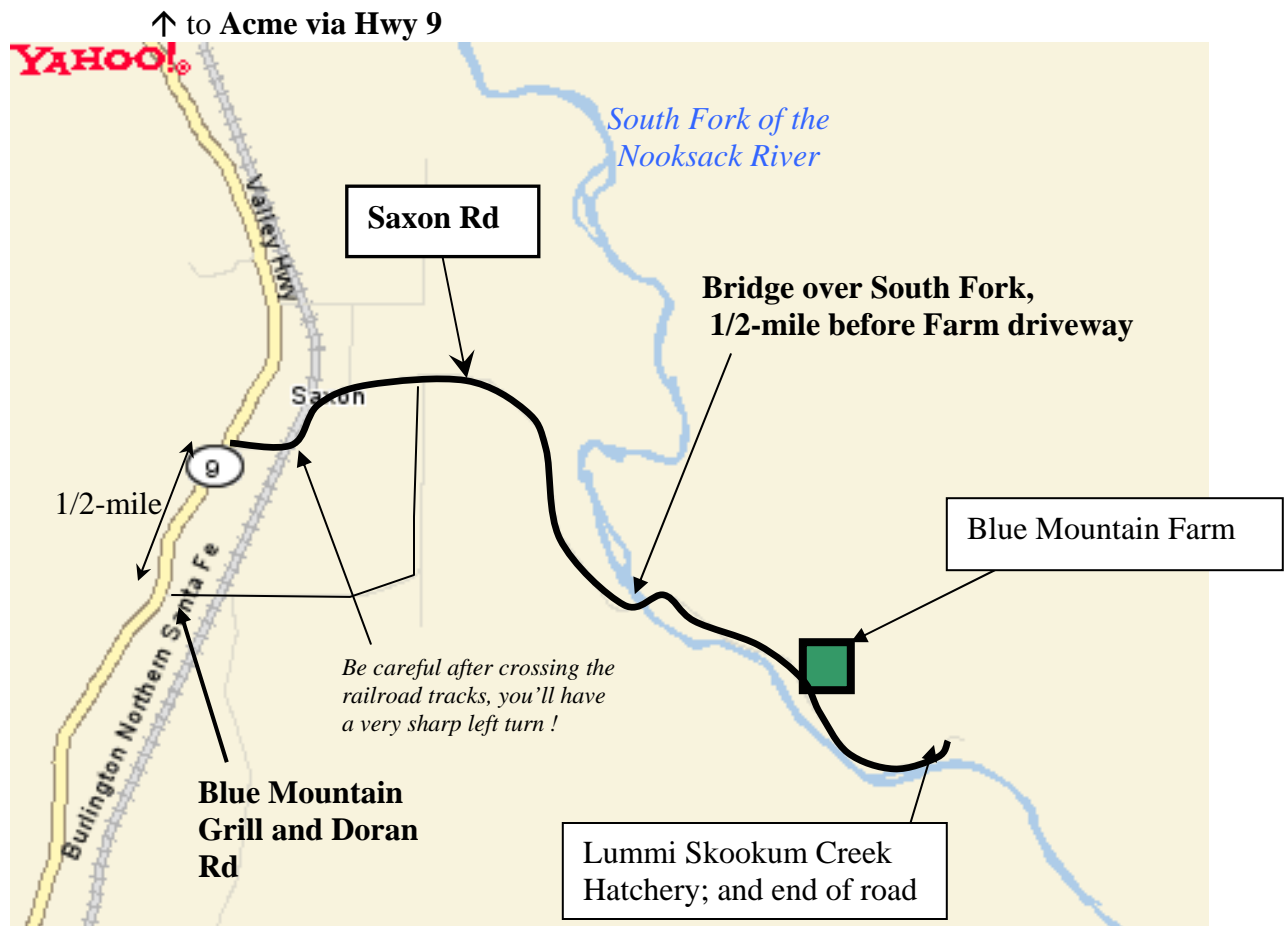


Directions to the Lodge at Blue Mountain Farm from the south

- Travel northbound on I-5 to Exit 232, Cook Road, just north of Burlington (two miles north of the Highway 20 interchange so you can avoid the stoplights and traffic).
- Turn right (east) on Cook Road for about **4.3 miles** until it intersects with Highway 20; then turn left (east) and stay on Hwy 20 for just over **a mile** into Sedro-Woolley until it intersects with Highway 9/Township Street at a stoplight. Turn left (north) onto Highway 9. It's signed "To Sumas".
- On Hwy 9, you will enter Whatcom County and pass through the tiny town of Wickersham. Just over **12 miles** from the turnoff in Sedro-Woolley, you will pass the Blue Mountain Grill restaurant and the adjacent intersection with Doran Road. **One-half (0.5) mile** past the Grill/Doran Road, turn right onto Saxon Road, which you will stay on for **2.5 miles**.
- While on Saxon Road, you will cross a bridge over the South Fork of the Nooksack River, and about **0.5 mile** past that bridge watch for a white sign on your left saying "Blue Mountain Farm." Enter the driveway and follow it as it makes a hard curve to the left – you can park on the gravel alongside the driveway to the left or go past the brown house to the parking area.
